MY DEAR SIR -

I hear AND read OF a recent
INCIDENT INVOLVING YOUR DELEGATION.

IT SEEMS THAT A WOOLY HEADED
APE OF A NIGGOR INSIDIOUSLY
ENTRENCHED HIMSELF INTO YOUR
ENTOURAGE AND CLEARLY PERFORMED
SOME UNCIVILIZED COON DANCE IN
THE AISLES WHEN RED CHINA WAS
ADMITTED TO THAT AUGUST BODY -
THE GREAT U. N.

I THINK IT A TERRIBLE SHAME THAT
SUCH CONDUIT ON THE PART OF
AN OBVIOUSLY DEMENTED HALF-HUMAN
HALF-APE CARICATURE OF A MAN
SHOULD BRING IGNOMINY TO THE
