Salim pays visits to refugee centres

UN GENERAL Assembly President Salim Ahmed Salim yesterday paid visits to UN-sponsored refugee holding centres along the Thai-Kampuchean border.

Salim, after receiving a briefing on the situation along the border, toured the Khao I-Dang refugee centre, Thailand's biggest refugee camp which houses about 113,000 Kampucheans.

He returned to Bangkok last night for an audience with Their Majesties the King and Queen.

Salim, who arrived here on Thursday, had talks with Foreign Minister Siddhi Savetsila and Premier Prem Tinsulanonda on regional affairs, particularly the Kampuchean problem.

He is scheduled to leave today.
